Dear Florida State Attorneys:

We, BradyCops.Org, file this public record request for any list your office has compiled, maintains or references in the identification of police officers within your jurisdiction who would be commonly classified as “Brady Cops”.

Our classification of the term “Brady Cops” would include police officers that have a known history of misconduct that would call into question their veracity. So much so, that their lack of veracity could be reportable exculpatory evidence to the criminal defendant, in compliance with the mandates of the 1963 U.S. Supreme Court decision – Brady v. Maryland 373 U.S. 83.

Our (BradyCops.Org) goal is to develop a nationwide database of all available “Brady Cop” lists held by U.S. prosecutors. We, intend to publish all Florida Brady lists within the below linked web page.

Further, our goal is to make the public aware of jurisdictions that do not maintain a Brady Cop list – and openly question how those jurisdictions honestly comply with the reporting mandates of the Brady decision. Therefore, should your office not maintain a Brady Cop list – we would request that your office provide us with a written explanation of how it complies with the mandates of the Brady decision. This written explanation will be published in lieu of a Brady list.

We anticipate that defense attorneys within your jurisdiction will either confirm, or challenge your written explanation.

Given recent events, we are confident that your office can appreciate the public interest in whether their prosecuting attorneys' are properly vetting out the credibility of our nation's law enforcement officers. Further, we are sure, that you also appreciate that your office's credibility image could be directly attached as to whether, it was or was not complying with U.S. Supreme Court mandates, such as the Brady decision.
