Dear Sir or Madam,

I am writing in response to your public records request addressed to various prosecutors in Vermont.

Vermont is a state of small, close-knit communities with a population of just over 600,000 and an average county population of just over 42,000. Our county prosecutors have historically relied on their personal knowledge of law enforcement officials to fulfill their Brady and Giglio obligations. In a state where it is not hyperbole to suggest that we know one another on a first name basis, this informal system has served us well. However, in August 2015, the Vermont State's Attorneys' Practices and Procedures Committee voted to formalize the Giglio compliance process by creating a centralized system to house such information regarding law enforcement officers. We are currently in the process of developing this system and expect a finished product within six months.
